


STUDENT ENROLLMENT & STAFFING



SAMPLE OF GROWTH

- 2022-23 added 95 Single Family Homes in district (city limits)
- **Cedar Point**: 200+ (2020-2023) built, with 50 homes to be built per developer.
- Brushy Creek Ranches: 13 homes built, with 1 currently in construction.
- Magnolia Creek Ranches: 80 homesites available.
- Idlewilde: 45 homes to be built over the next 5 years per developer.

CHALLENGES

Onalaska Elementary

- 720 students (PreK-6th grade)
- All classrooms are occupied/no room for future staff needs
- Eight grade levels at Onalaska Elementary
 - large grade span (3 years to 13 years old)
 - lunches run from 10:30 to 1:20
- Traffic congestion for drop-off & pick-up
- Limited extra-curricular for 5th & 6th graders
 - pre-athletics, band, choir, LDC/JROTC

CHALLENGES

Onalaska Junior Senior High

- 540 students ($7^{\text{th-}}12^{\text{th}}$ grades)
- One classroom left for future staffing needs
- Large span between age differences (12 years to 19 years)
- CTE (Career Technology Education) classrooms not originally designed for that purpose
- Conflicts created by shared facilities
 - practice schedules, hosted events
- Small gymnasium and parking eliminates ability to host graduation in Onalaska

OPPORTUNITIES *Onalaska High School*

Building OHS

- Creates availability for future growth at all 3 campuses
- Allows district to realign grade levels (PreK-4, 5-8, 9-12)
- Provides purpose designed facilities for CTE programs
- Allows extra-curricular programs for 5^{th} & 6^{th} graders
- Reduces traffic congestion at Onalaska Elementary
- Improves scheduling and lunch times at Onalaska Elementary
- Physical education and athletic facilities on each campus
- Provides opportunity for local graduation, hosting competitions, and provides facilities for community use and events

M&O - Maintenance and

Operations tax rate funds the general operations of the District. M&O is primarily determined at the state level.

I&S - Interest and

Sinking tax rate funds the debt generated by the issuance of schoolhouse bonds. I&S is primarily controlled at the local level and requires the approval of voters.

Total - the total tax rate is a combination of the M&O and I&S tax rates.
